NEW BUSINESS:

1. Distribution of Membership Badges – Membership Committee – Mike Leen/ Dick Boberg

- At our Jan. Executive Committee meeting with the Membership Committee, Mike Leen gave a presentation of the distribution of Membership Badges. Since the Membership Committee had originally requested that the budget for 2020 be increased for the cost of badges, (nearly double), the Executive Committee at their Nov. meeting approved a recommendation decreasing the number of badges given out. They recommended that one badge only be given to each new regular member and if a family member wants one, they would have to pay for it.

In our discussion with Mike, the Executive Committee agreed to compromise by approving a motion to limit distribution to one badge per regular- "Active" member. If a family member is involved and will be the "Active" member, that member would get the badge. A supporting member would be given one badge. Any additional badges would be paid for separately. This requires membership approval.

MOTION: Limit distribution of badges to one active member in a Family/Regular membership and supporting members will receive one badge. If more badges are wanted by "Inactive" members, they may purchase additional badges.

VOTE: The Motion passed.
